RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE SOUTH CENTRAL ARMSTRONG REGIONAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE, AUTHORIZING SIGNATORIES, AND PLEDGING MATCHING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Gilpin Township, in collaboration with Parks Township, Bethel Township, and Leechburg Borough, will be undertaking a project to update the South Central Armstrong County Comprehensive Plan to better address current and future municipal priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development provides grants-in-aid through the Local Share Account Fund Program for projects that support infrastructure, economic development, and community enhancement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Gilpin Township, Bethel Township, and Parks Township, and the Council of the Borough of Leechburg recognizes the importance of this project as a priority investment to support regional collaboration and sustainable development goals; and

WHEREAS, the Township is committed to leveraging grant funds to maximize the impact of the comprehensive plan update and will act as the lead municipality in obtaining grant funds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Gilpin Township hereby resolves as follows, incorporating the above recitals by reference.

- 1. The Board of Supervisors authorizes submission of an application to the Municipal Assistance Program for a grant in the amount of \$50,000 to support the regional comprehensive plan update project.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors pledges \$12,500 to the completion of the project as matching funds.
- 3. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the SWPA Municipal Project Hub and Representatives of Gilpin Township to prepare and submit an application on behalf of the Township and, where necessary, act on its behalf.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors designates the Board of Supervisors Chairman and Township Secretary as the Officials to execute all documents and agreements necessary to facilitate obtaining the requested grant.
- 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
